2023 EQUINE RULES

1. Be courteous of everyone around you. Safety First!
2. The owner of the horse is responsible for any damage that occurs to the stall, the equine, or persons in the stall.
3. DO NOT go into someone else's stall.
4. Clean out stalls daily, and strip the stall completely after moving horse out, put manure in manure pile.
5. NO sitting, lying, or riding on the equine in the barns.
6. DO NOT tie equines to front of stalls or bars, tie to secure post or corner.
7. NO clipping or grooming of equine in the barn aisles.
8. NO riding in halter and rope, must have a bridle on.
9. Walk or slow trot only to and from arenas.
10. NO riding double or bareback
11. All riders must wear boots. Appropriate footwear is required at all times.
12. NO horses in camping areas or in bleacher areas
13. NO equine may be tied with the bridle reins or with the chain over the nose or under the chin or through the mouth at any place or time
14. DO NOT tie to the arena fencing
15. NO turn out in arenas, equine must be in hand
16. ALL RIDERS age 19 and younger must wear a properly fitted headgear which meets or exceeds current ASTM/SEI standards with the chin harness fastened at all times.
17. NO DOGS permitted in/around barns or arenas.
18. Quiet time in barns 11 pm- 6 am
