

Ottawa County 4-H CARTEENS Scholarship

The Ottawa County 4-H CARTEENS program will offer two \$250 scholarships to eligible high school graduates who plan to attend post-secondary education in the fall of the current year. The scholarship may be applied toward any post-secondary education at an accredited institution of higher learning and may be received only one time.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

- ▶ Must be a senior in Ottawa County, graduating in the class of 2023
- ▶ Have a minimum of a 3.0 high school GPA
- ▶ Have volunteered as a 4-H CARTEENS facilitator within the last year
- ▶ Will be enrolled in post-secondary education in the fall of 2024
