## **Equipment & Cost Considerations**

- Costs of Goats can vary and start around \$125
- · Cost of feeds can vary
- Goats grow best when they have at least a three-sided shelter to provide them with protection from sun, wind, and rain.
- Shavings and straw should be used for bedding especially in early spring when temperatures are cold.
- A clean continuous water supply is needed.
- Goats should be wormed 2-3 times during the project

#### **Items Needed for the Fair:**

- Registration papers (if registration tattoo)
- Must provide your own waterer
- · Show box that locks to keep your supplies in
- · Feeder, feed tub or pan
- Brushes
- Collars and Leads
- Shampoo
- Shavings
- Hoof Trimmers
- Clippers

**Dress code:** Tie shoes or boots (no open toed shoes) long pants and plain, short sleeve or long-sleeved shirts.
