Tack/ Outfits by Class

Contest

Boots, jeans, long sleeve button up shirt, helmet, western saddle, bridle and tack. See rulebook for bit guidelines.

Western

Boots, jeans, long sleeve button up shirt, helmet western saddle, bridle and tack. See rulebook for bit guidelines.

English

English saddle, saddle pad, English bridle, helmet, English boots, breeches, show shirt and jacket.

Showmanship/In Hand

No chaps/spurs, western hat or ASTM approved helmet, long sleeve show shirt, long pants, boots, show halter (not nylon) and lead (chain optional).
