Members must:

- ☐ Enroll in 4-H by the April 1st Deadline
- ☐ Tag-in animal(s) must be brought to tagging day on May 4th at the fairgrounds (times TBD)
- Attend Quality Assurance training
- ☐ Complete registration for fair exhibits Blue Ribbon online (register between 5/1-6/1)
- ☐ Complete a Project Book and attend Livestock Judging and Skill-a-thon (July)
- ☐ Bring Hog to fair at scheduled weigh in time.

Equipment & Cost Considerations

- Costs of pigs can vary and start around \$125.
- Cost of feeds can vary, and pigs can eat on average 2 to 6+ pounds of feed a day (depending on their age).
- Pigs grow best when they have at least a three-sided shelter to provide them with protection from sun, wind, and rain.
 Shavings and straw should be used for bedding, especially in early spring when temperatures are cold.
- A clean continuous water supply is needed.
- Pigs should be wormed 2-3 times during the project.

Exhibiting a Market Hog Project

Items needed for the fair:

- · Show box that locks to keep your supplies in
- · Feeder, feed tub or pan
- · Show cane or whip
- Brushes
- · Spray bottle
- Shampoo
- Shavings
- Floor mats are optional but recommended as the floor in the Livestock Building is slippery.

Dress code: Tie shoes or boots (no open toed shoes) long pants and plain, short sleeve or long-sleeved shirts.

*Pigs must have a minimum weight of 200 pounds. Pigs under 200lbs at the official weigh-in will be sent home or given the option to stay and show in showmanship class. They will not go thru the sale.

Additional Information

Both barrows and gilts may be used.
