- Complete and submit the Volunteer Application at <https://go.osu.edu/ottawavolunteerapplication>
- Submit information for a minimum of 3 references (this is part of the application process)
- Register yourself in 4HOnline as an adult volunteer <https://ottawa.osu.edu/program-areas/4-h-youth-development/4-h-online-20>
- Complete your BCI/FBI background check and submit results to OSU HR <https://ottawa.osu.edu/program-areas/4-h-youth-development/volunteers>
- Attend an interview with your 4-H professional
- Attend a New Volunteer Orientation
- Attend the required Youth Protection Training (Policy 1.50)
- Complete any additional program specific volunteer trainings (i.e. Cloverbud)
- Receive Official Letter of Status
